HOW TO USE THIS PLAN

# One year. The whole story.

This plan guides you through the entire Bible chronologically over one year — reading events roughly in the order they happened. Each week gives you six daily readings and a grace day to rest, reflect, or catch up. You don't have to be perfect; you just have to keep showing up.

**Ask God to speak.**

Reading the Bible isn't just informative — it's transformative. Before you read, ask God to give you ears to hear what He wants to say to you.

**Don't rush.**

It's easy to read too much, too fast. Take it slow. Ask yourself two questions: What is this passage saying? And why do I need to know it?

**Write it down.**

Note the things that “pop” as you read. The S.O.A.P. method below is a simple way to capture what God is showing you.
