The First 30 Days.

"Your word is a lamp for my feet, a light on my path."

PSALM 119:105

HOW TO USE THIS

Ten minutes a day, for thirty days.

The hardest part of reading the Bible is knowing where to start. This plan takes that decision off your plate. One short passage a day for a month — a guided walk through the life of Jesus, the early church, and who you are now.

Find a regular time and place — first coffee, lunch break, before bed. Keep it short and keep it daily; a little, often, is how a relationship grows. And if you miss a day, don't start over and don't quit. Just pick up where you left off.

Each day, move through four simple steps:

Read	The passage for the day. Slowly — out loud if it helps.
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Reflect	What does this show me about God? About myself?
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Respond	One small thing to do, change, or thank God for today.
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Pray	Talk to God about what you just read. That's it.

DAYS 1–10 · THE GOSPEL OF JOHN

Before anything else, get to know the person at the center of it all.

Day 01	John 1:1–18	The Word became flesh. God stepped into the world in person.
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Day 02	John 3:1–21	Born again. What it means to start over with God.
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Day 03	John 4:1–26	Living water. Jesus meets a woman everyone else avoided.
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Day 04	John 6:25–40	The bread of life. The hunger only He can fill.
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Day 05	John 8:1–11	Grace over judgment. “Neither do I condemn you.”
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Day 06	John 10:1–18	The good shepherd. He knows you and lays down His life.
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Day 07	John 11:1–44	The resurrection and the life. Death doesn’t get the last word.
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Day 08	John 13:1–17	Love that serves. The King washes feet.
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Day 09	John 19:16–30	“It is finished.” The cross, and what it paid for.
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Day 10	John 20:1–31	He is risen. The empty tomb changes everything.
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The early church DAYS 11–17 · THE BOOK OF ACTS

See what happened when ordinary people followed Jesus together.

Day 11	Acts 1:1–11	The mission begins. Jesus' last words and first instructions.
Day 12	Acts 2:1–13	The Spirit arrives. God's power poured out on the church.
Day 13	Acts 2:42–47	The blueprint. Word, fellowship, bread, and prayer.
Day 14	Acts 3:1–10	More than money. "What I have, I give you."
Day 15	Acts 4:1–20	Bold and unschooled. Courage from time spent with Jesus.
Day 16	Acts 9:1–19	Anyone can change. The enemy of the church becomes its voice.
Day 17	Acts 16:16–34	Singing in chains. Joy that circumstances can't touch.

Wisdom & prayer DAYS 18–24 · PSALMS & PROVERBS

Learn to talk to God honestly — and to live wisely.

Day 18	Psalm 1	Two paths. The life that's rooted and the life that blows away.
Day 19	Psalm 23	The Shepherd's care. A psalm to memorize for hard days.
Day 20	Psalm 51	An honest confession. How to come back after you've fallen.
Day 21	Psalm 103	Don't forget. A running list of who God is and what He does.
Day 22	Psalm 139	Fully known. There's nowhere you are that God isn't.
Day 23	Proverbs 3:1–12	Trust over understanding. Lean on Him, not just yourself.
Day 24	Proverbs 4:20–27	Guard your heart. What you take in shapes the way you go.

Who you are now DAYS 25–30 · ROMANS & EPHESIANS

Stand on what's true of you because of Jesus.

Day 25	Romans 5:1–11	At peace with God. Loved while you were still a mess.
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Day 26	Romans 8:1–17	No condemnation. Free, and led by the Spirit.
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Day 27	Romans 8:31–39	Nothing can separate you. The love that won't let go.
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Day 28	Ephesians 2:1–10	Saved by grace. A gift, not a wage — so no one can boast.
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Day 29	Ephesians 3:14–21	Rooted in love. A prayer to grasp how loved you are.
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Day 30	Ephesians 4:1–16	Built together. You're part of something bigger now.
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"Being confident of this, that he who began a good work in you will carry it on to completion."
